

Adult Scholarship Policy

September 3, 2018

MISSION:

To provide a program that will award a scholarship to encourage and assist adults who wish to attend a Christian event, such as a Christian weekend retreat, but need financial assistance.

FUNDING:

All scholarships will be awarded from church funds, as designated each year in the Annual Church Budget.

AUTHORIZATON:

The Board of Administration shall approve any activity or event that shall be eligible for a scholarship. The Senior Pastor shall determine the financial need of any individual(s) requesting a scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

- Scholarships will range up to the maximum amount of the event, or as determined by the Board of Administration, and/or budget restraints.
- All Scholarship checks will be made out to the event, unless proof is provided that the fee has already been paid.

APPLICANTS:

- Applicants must be an active attendee of CCF, as work and health issues allow; exceptions only with the Board of Administration approval.

APPLICANTS SHALL SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING:

- CCF Adult Scholarship Application obtained from the church office.

EXCEPTIONS:

Pastors and other Ministry Leaders who attend seminars directly related to their responsibilities within the Church may have their expenses fully paid, regardless of their financial situation, upon approval of the Board of Administration.
