College Scholarship Policy

May 6, 2019

MISSION

To provide a program that will award scholarships to encourage and assist students with plans to attend college.

FUNDING

• All scholarships will be awarded from church funds, as designated for each year in the Annual Church Budget.

COMMITTEE

Committee shall be comprised of a minimum of two members as follows:

- At least one, but no more than two members at large.
- At least one, but no more than two, from the youth program; either a youth pastor or youth leader.

Final determination of members rests with the Board of Administration.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- Scholarships will consist of \$500.00 to be awarded as follows
 - o One half of the awarded scholarship will be given prior to the start of the first semester.
 - o The second half of the scholarship will be awarded the following semester provided they are actively involved in some sort of Christian ministry at the college or are regularly attending a local church. They must provide the name and address of a local contact to verify ministry involvement.
- Recipients may apply for a scholarship once each year that they attend college.
- Any person whose chosen field of study is in Christian ministry or related field (e.g. pastoral studies, youth ministry, missions, etc.) will receive a double scholarship.
- All scholarship monies will be given directly to the college applicant.

APPLICANTS

- High school seniors and college undergraduates may apply.
- Must be actively involved in the ministries at CCF.
- Must be pursuing at least an undergraduate degree program.
- Applicants are required to be full-time students according to their school's standards for the program for which they are enrolled.
