Dear Parent/Guardian:

Welcome to Awana at Chemung Christian Fellowship! Awana is a global, nonprofit ministry committed to the belief that the greatest impact for Christ starts with kids who know, love and serve Him. We are excited to get to know and spend time with your child and share Jesus with him or her. Thank you for entrusting your child with us!

Chemung Christian Fellowship will hold Awana Wednesdays from 6:30-8:00pm. Each week will have a specific theme, which is listed on the Awana Schedule. Clubbers earn points for attendance, completing sections in their handbooks, church attendance, and participating in the theme. Each time Clubbers earn 25,000 points, they earn a prize from the Prize Box.

Awana at CCF will follow the Waverly school calendar. If, due to bad weather, Waverly closes school or cancels after-school activities, Awana will be canceled too. It will be posted, as soon as possible, on the church website ([www.chemungchristianfellowship.com](http://www.chemungchristianfellowship.com)) and the church and CCF Kids Facebook pages. If Waverly closes due to a health concern, the CCF Board of Administration will determine whether Awana and other church activities are canceled. This decision will then be communicated by the same methods for a weather related cancellation.

The health and safety of all children and families who come to CCF is of great importance to us. In order to keep everyone as safe as possible, we are taking the following precautions:

- Temperature checks for all children, parents, volunteers, and visitors upon arrival.
- Masks required for everyone, except Puggles, when social distancing is not possible.
- Commonly used surfaces (tables, chairs, etc.) will be disinfected between uses.
- Commonly used items (handrails, door knobs, bathrooms, etc.) will be disinfected frequently.
- Gloves will be used, and changed frequently, when distributing items to Clubbers or handling their books, Bibles, and other belongings.
- Pre-packaged snacks will be given at snack time.
- Frequent hand sanitizer and hand washing encouraged.
- One way traffic in the building, where possible.
- Weekly health screening questionnaire by text or email regarding recent symptoms and travel.

CCF believes that children are important and is offering Awana at no cost to families. Clubbers will be given *one* book and uniform. If a Clubber's book or uniform is lost, it can be replaced at the expense of the parent. (Books are approximately \$10 and uniforms are approximately \$15.)

Due to the ongoing pandemic, we will not be offering a dinner prior to our Wednesday evening activities. If we are able to offer the dinner at a later date, we will announce it a week or two in advance.

If your Clubber does not have a Bible, please let a leader know. We would be happy to give your child a Bible.
